A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Hilsman Middle School as the 2002 State Champions of the Academic Bowl
2 for Middle Grades and inviting the team, coaches, and principal to appear before this body;

4 WHEREAS, the Academic Bowl for Middle Grades is an annual scholastic competition
5 sponsored by the Professional Association of Georgia Educators (PAGE) Foundation for
6 students in grades six, seven and eight that includes more than 1,500 students from 140
7 public school systems and private schools in Georgia and inspires students to excel

10 title as the 2002 State Champion in a finale contest with Lee County Middle School; and

16 discipline, and determination and their accomplishments merit the highest praise.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
18 this body recognizes and commends Hilsman Middle school as the state champions in the
19 2002 Academic Bowl for Middle Grades and invites the team, coaches, and the school
20 principal to appear before this body at a time to be determined by the Speaker of the House.
