A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the State Court of Spalding County, approved December 14, 1897
2 (Ga. L. 1897, p. 462), as amended, particularly by an Act approved February 21, 1980
3 (Ga. L. 1980, p. 3048), so as to change the terms of said court; to provide for related matters;
4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 **SECTION 1.**

7 An Act creating the State Court of Spalding County, approved December 14, 1897 (Ga. L.
8 1897, p. 462), as amended, particularly by an Act approved February 21, 1980 (Ga. L. 1980,
9 p. 3048), is amended by striking Section 17 in its entirety and inserting in its place a new
10 Section 17 to read as follows:

11 "SECTION 17.

12 The regular terms of the State Court of Spalding County shall begin on the first Monday
13 in March, and continuing until the next term of said court; the first Monday in May, and
14 continuing until the next term of said court; the first Monday in August, and continuing
15 until the next term of said court; and the first Monday in November, and continuing until
16 the next term of said court. Adjourned and special terms of court may be called as needed
17 by the judge of said court."

18 **SECTION 2.**

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
