A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the Dougherty County School System High School/High Tech Program and
2 inviting the students and teachers to appear before the House of Representatives; and for
3 other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the Dougherty County School System High School/High Tech Program was
5 organized during the summer of 1997 as an educational enrichment program for high school
6 students with disabilities who are interested in pursuing careers in science, technology, and
7 engineering; and

8 WHEREAS, the program is designed to develop career opportunities and provide activities
9 that will spark an interest in high-technology fields and to encourage students to pursue
10 higher education; and

11 WHEREAS, students are selected to participate in the program from four Dougherty County
12 high schools: Albany High School, Dougherty High School, Monroe High School, and
13 Westover High School; and

14 WHEREAS, the program incorporates a mix of learning experiences that include high-tech
15 classroom learning, paid summer internships, mentoring, workshops and training, and job
16 shadowing and site visits; and

17 WHEREAS, since its establishment, the program has given students with disabilities the
18 support to help them realize that they can accomplish their dreams.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body recognize the Dougherty County School System High School/High
21 Tech Program and congratulate the participants on their outstanding accomplishments.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the students and teachers of the Dougherty County
2 School System High School/High Tech Program are invited to appear before the House of
3 Representatives at a date and time to be determined by the Speaker of the House of
4 Representatives.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
6 and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Dougherty County
7 School System High School/High Tech Program.
