18 selected as the 2002 Westfield Schools STAR Teacher.

20 the members of this body express regret at the passing of William Kinlock Gottwals, convey
21 condolences to his family, and commend William Kinlock Gottwals for his sacrifice,

2 congratulate his family upon his selection as the 2002 Westfield Schools STAR Teacher.
