A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To provide for a nonbinding referendum for residents of the Glynn County School District
- 2 regarding reconstituting the Glynn County Board of Education; to repeal conflicting laws;
- 3 and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Unless prohibited by the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended, the election
- 7 superintendent of Glynn County shall call and conduct an election as provided in this section
- 8 for the purpose of submitting a question to the electors of the Glynn County School District.
- 9 The election superintendent shall conduct that election on the date of the November general
- 10 election in 2002 and shall issue the call and conduct that election as provided by general law.
- 11 The superintendent shall cause the date and purpose of the election to be published once a
- week for two weeks immediately preceding the date of the election in the official organ of
- 13 Glynn County. The ballot shall have written or printed thereon the words:
- 14 "() YES Shall a bill be introduced into the General Assembly providing for the
- reconstitution of the Glynn County Board of Education into a board
- 16 () NO consisting of five members elected from single-member districts and two members elected from the county at large?"
- 17 All persons desiring to vote for approval of the Act shall vote "Yes," and those persons
- desiring to vote for rejection of the Act shall vote "No." The expense of such election shall
- 19 be borne by Glynn County.

SECTION 2.

21 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
