- 2 WHEREAS, Tommie Lee Grier was born on April 23, 1916, the beloved son of loving
3 parents, Johnny Grier and Alberta Daily Grier; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was baptized at an early age and joined the St. James Baptist Church in
5 Worth County, Georgia; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he was educated in the public schools of West Palm Beach, Florida; and

8 the 1940's, and following his discharge from service returned home to help his family run
9 the family farm; and
