A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life of Deacon James R. Hall, Sr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, James R. Hall, Sr., the son of the late Nelson Hall and Indiana Porter Hall, was
3 born May 18, 1917, in Lee County, Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he moved with his family to Worth County, Georgia, in 1923 where they
5 continued their livelihood by farming; and
- 6 WHEREAS, as a teenager, he became a member of the Bright Morning Star Baptist Church
7 and later moved his membership to the Pleasant Grove Baptist Church where he served as
8 a deacon for as long as his health permitted; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was a kind man who never met a stranger, whose hand was always extended,
10 and whose mind was open to share and receive; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was a man of action, as a farmer and a builder, who engaged in construction
12 work from Florida to Atlanta while operating a farm in Worth County to support his family;
13 and
- 14 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Worth County Young Farmers Association; and
- 15 WHEREAS, as an active member in the St. Paul Association, he visited the different church
16 Sunday schools and monitored their progress; and
- 17 WHEREAS, he was joined in Holy Matrimony to Lollie Mae Walker in 1938 and to their
18 loving union six children were born; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he raised his children on the farm and taught them to be loving and hard
20 working; and

1 WHEREAS, he taught the ways of God by the example of his own life and faithfulness.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
3 the members of this body honor the life and memory of Deacon James R. Hall, Sr., and
4 express their deep condolences to his family.
