A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Mr. W. Randall "Randy" Clayton; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Mr. W. Randall "Randy" Clayton, after first serving as an intern for the General
3 Assembly of Georgia in 1983 and later as an employee of the Department of Public Safety
4 and the state-wide probation system, was employed by the Georgia General Assembly in
5 January, 1987, as director of the Georgia Criminal Justice Improvement Council and
6 continued in that position for 14 years until October, 2001; and

7 WHEREAS, Mr. Clayton served in that capacity faithfully supporting members of the
8 General Assembly and legislative committees in their endeavor to provide and improve
9 criminal justice; and

10 WHEREAS, Mr. Clayton collected, managed, coordinated, and presented public safety
11 information on behalf of the Georgia legislature which furthered criminal justice efforts for
12 many years; and

13 WHEREAS, Mr. Clayton acted as a dedicated and loyal public servant providing assistance
14 to citizens, state employees, and legislative staff alike who were in need of guidance or
15 direction in their pursuit of criminal justice information; and

16 WHEREAS, Mr. Clayton accepted a position with the Georgia Department of Motor
17 Vehicles where he serves in the capacity of deputy assistant to the commissioner and where
18 he continues to serve the state, members of the General Assembly, and the general public to
19 the best of his ability; and

20 WHEREAS, Mr. Clayton is known to all those who have worked with him in his position
21 with the General Assembly as an individual eager to help, kind to all, and a true Georgia
22 gentleman.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
2 the members of this body commend and express their appreciation for Mr. W. Randall
3 "Randy" Clayton and his dedicated service to the General Assembly of Georgia, the public
4 for which we serve, and this state.
