- 2 WHEREAS, Ray A. Adams is well known in Carroll County, Georgia, where he has been
3 a highly effective and superbly dedicated civic and community leader who has influenced
4 the lives of countless fellow citizens and the livelihood of numerous local businesses; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he came to Carroll County in 1960 after college at the University of Georgia
6 as an Assistant County Agent and became County Agent Chairman by 1965, and his personal
7 initiative and service to agricultural interests earned him tremendous respect and esteem; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was the Manager Legislative Affairs and Economic Development for the
9 Carroll Electric Membership Corporation for 25 years beginning in 1970 and was a vital
10 participant on numerous committees and a valued contact with state and national leaders; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in addition to his exceptional professional career, he contributed generously to
12 community organizations, serving as president of the Chamber of Commerce and of the
13 Civitan Club for three terms; the Chattahoochee Flint RDC Chairman; member of the
14 Governor's Development Council; and as Deacon of the First Baptist Church since 1965; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he received the Distinguished Service Award for 2000 from the National Food
16 and Energy Council Board of Directors for his superior community service, and it is most
17 appropriate that this distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized and honored.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body recognize and commend Ray A. Adams for his outstanding role
20 as a superb civic, business, and community leader in Carrollton and Carroll County, Georgia.
