A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring the life of Mr. Thomas Eugene "BoJack" Outlaw; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Thomas Eugene "BoJack" Outlaw was born December 9, 1933, to the late Mr.
3 Andrew York Outlaw, Sr., and the late Mrs. Emma Gray Outlaw; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he attended school in Worth and Tift Counties, Georgia, and joined the
5 Solomon Chapel AME Church at an early age; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he served honorably as a member of the United States Army during the Korean
7 War; and
- 8 WHEREAS, in 1957, he chose Minnie Giddens to be his wife, and, to their loving union, one
9 son was born, Thomas E. Outlaw, Jr.; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was a lifetime farmer who owned and successfully operated his own farm;

- 12 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Worth County Young Farmers Association; and
- 13 WHEREAS, his love and concern for children led him to become a school bus driver and he
14 served with great dedication in that capacity for 37 years and received the "Bus Driver of the
15 Year Award" from the Worth County School System for 1993-1994; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he served as a steward at Solomon Chapel AME Church, served as a member
17 of the Agricultural Advisory Committee, the Worth County ASCS Committee, and the Worth
18 County Young Farmers Association and was a charter member of the Worth County
19 NAACP; and
- 20 WHEREAS, his memory will be cherished dearly by his family, friends, and community.
