## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Mr. Charles John "Jake" Lindsey; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Charles John "Jake" Lindsey was born in Locust Grove, Georgia, on December  
3 17, 1917, the son of the late Charlie Daniel and Irene Lucille Kimbell Lindsey; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he owned and operated Lindsey Grocery Store in Locust Grove before he  
5 retired in 1982; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Mr. Lindsey served his country in the United States Army during World War  
7 II; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was a member of the Locust Grove United Methodist Church which he  
9 served faithfully in numerous capacities; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he served his community as a member of the SPLOST Oversight Committee,  
11 the Board of Directors for the Council on Aging, and the board at Simpsonwood; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was a representative for the district Selective Service Board, and served as  
13 District Lay Leader at Large for the Griffin District, as a volunteer for Meals on Wheels, and  
14 as a volunteer for the distribution of surplus food and energy assistant program for Henry  
15 County; and
- 16 WHEREAS, his most cherished moments were derived from visiting nursing homes and  
17 persons who were shut-ins; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he was a loving husband to his wife, Lorene Marshall Lindsey, a devoted  
19 brother, and a dear friend.

1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
2 the members of this body pay tribute to the life of Charles John "Jake" Lindsey, express their  
3 gratitude for his exemplary service to the State of Georgia, and extend their sincere
