- 1 Commending former Milledgeville Police Chief Eugene Ellis; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Eugene Ellis served with distinction as Chief of the Milledgeville Police
3 Department from 1949 until 1975, after having begun his career with the department in 1946;

- 5 WHEREAS, he later served his community as City Marshal from 1975 to 1977 and as Chief
6 Deputy Sheriff of Baldwin County from 1977 until his retirement in 1983; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he is a U.S. Army veteran of World War II, having served honorably in New
8 Guinea and the Philippines and stateside in the military police; and
- 9 WHEREAS, it is only fitting and proper that his life of public service be recognized by this
10 body.
- 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
12 the members of this body commend former Milledgeville Police Chief Eugene Ellis for his
13 lengthy career as a law enforcement officer and for his many contributions to the welfare of
14 his community, state, and nation.
