A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 1 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 general provisions regarding food, drugs, and cosmetics, so as to provide that the owner or
3 manager of a food service establishment may refuse to serve any person having control or
4 charge of a child under the age of seven years while such person and child are seated in a
5 designated smoking area; to define a certain term; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
6 purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 Chapter 1 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
10 provisions regarding food, drugs, and cosmetics, is amended by adding at the end thereof a
11 new Code Section 26-1-2 to read as follows:

12 "26-1-2.

13 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'food service establishment' shall have the same
14 meaning as provided in Code Section 26-2-370.

15 (b) The owner or manager of a food service establishment, or his or her designee, may
16 refuse to serve any person having control or charge of a child under the age of seven years
17 while such person and child are seated in any indoor area of the food service establishment
18 which is clearly designated by a smoking-permitted sign."

19 **SECTION 2.**

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
