

The House Committee on State Planning and Community Affairs - Local Legislation offered the following substitute to HB 1386:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Pierce County, approved March
2 25, 1937 (Ga. L. 1937, p. 1397), as amended, so as to change the description of the
3 commissioner districts; to provide for definitions and inclusions; to provide for continuation
4 in office of current members; to provide for submission of this Act for approval under the
5 federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as amended; to provide for effective dates; to repeal
6 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

8 An Act creating the Board of Commissioners of Pierce County, approved March 25, 1937
9 (Ga. L. 1937, p. 1397), as amended, is amended by striking subsections (a), (b), and (e) of
10 Section 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

12 "(a) There is created the Board of Commissioners of Pierce County. The board shall be
13 composed of five members to be elected as provided in this section. For purposes of
14 electing members of the board of commissioners, Pierce County is divided into four
15 commissioner districts. The four commissioner districts shall be and correspond to those
16 four numbered districts described in and attached to and made a part of this Act and further
17 identified as Plan Name: piercep2r Plan Type: Local User: Gina Administrator: Pierce
18 Co.

19 (b) When used in such attachment, the terms 'Tract' and 'BG' (Block Group) shall mean
20 and describe the same geographical boundaries as provided in the report of the Bureau of
21 the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. The
22 separate numeric designations in a Tract description which are underneath a 'BG' heading
23 shall mean and describe individual Blocks within a Block Group as provided in the report
24 of the Bureau of the Census for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of
25 Georgia. Any part of Pierce County which is not included in any such district described
26 in that attachment shall be included within that district contiguous to such part which

1 contains the least population according to the United States decennial census of 2000 for
2 the State of Georgia. Any part of Pierce County which is described in that attachment as
3 being in a particular district shall nevertheless not be included within such district if such
4 part is not contiguous to such district. Such noncontiguous part shall instead be included
5 within that district contiguous to such part which contains the least population according
6 to the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of Georgia. Except as otherwise
7 provided in the description of any commissioner district, whenever the description of such
8 district refers to a named city, it shall mean the geographical boundaries of that city as
9 shown on the census map for the United States decennial census of 2000 for the State of
10 Georgia."

11 "(e) Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4, as they exist immediately prior to June 1, 2002,
12 shall continue to be designated as Commissioner Districts 1, 2, 3, and 4, respectively, but
13 as newly described under this Act, and on and after June 1, 2002, such members of the
14 board serving from those former commissioner districts shall be deemed to be serving from
15 and representing their respective districts as newly described under this Act. Those
16 members of the Board of Commissioners of Pierce County who are serving as such on June
17 1, 2002, and any person selected to fill a vacancy in any such office shall continue to serve
18 as such members until the regular expiration of their respective terms of office and upon
19 the election and qualification of their respective successors."

20 SECTION 2.

21 It shall be the duty of the attorney of the Board of Commissioners of Pierce County to submit
22 this Act for approval pursuant to Section 5 of the federal Voting Rights Act of 1965, as
23 amended.

24 SECTION 3.

25 This section and Section 2 of this Act and those provisions of this Act necessary for the
26 election of members of the Board of Commissioners of Pierce County in 2002 shall become
27 effective upon the approval of this Act by the Governor or upon its becoming law without
28 such approval. The remaining provisions of this Act shall become effective June 1, 2002.

29 SECTION 4.

30 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
