

House Bill 1572

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 32-6-28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 permits for excess weight and dimensions of vehicles and loads, so as to change certain
3 provisions relating to duration and limits of and fees for permits; to repeal conflicting laws;
4 and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

7 Code Section 32-6-28 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to permits for
8 excess weight and dimensions of vehicles and loads, is amended in subsection (b) by
9 inserting a new paragraph to read as follows:

10 "(2.1) SIX-MONTH PERMIT. Six-month permits may be issued for loads of tobacco or
11 unginced cotton the widths of which do not exceed nine feet, provided that such loads
12 shall not be operated on the Dwight D. Eisenhower System of Interstate and Defense
13 Highways."

14 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

15 Said Code section is further amended by striking paragraph (3) of subsection (c) and
16 inserting in lieu thereof the following:

17 "(3) ~~FOUR~~ SIX MONTHS. The charges for the issuance of ~~four-month~~ six-month permits
18 for loads of tobacco ~~whose widths do not exceed nine feet~~ or unginced cotton shall be
19 \$25.00 per permit, ~~provided that such loads may not be operated on The Dwight D.~~
20 ~~Eisenhower System of Interstate and Defense Highways."~~

22 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
