

Senate Resolution 727

A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the mayor, council, municipal staff, and citizens of Lavonia, Georgia; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, comfortably nestled in northeast Georgia, the City of Lavonia is steeped in
4 history and described as the "Gem of the Piedmont"; and

5 WHEREAS, visitors are mesmerized by the simple country lifestyle in the historic
6 downtown, adorned by gazebos and murals; and

7 WHEREAS, the town is dotted with restored mansions depicting an inviting mixture of
8 traditional southern hospitality yet easy access to the south's largest cities; and

9 WHEREAS, Lavonia boasts opportunities for adventuresome recreation alongside Lake
10 Hartwell and profits from the formation and activities of the Lake Hartwell Marketing
11 Alliance; and

12 WHEREAS, the town is ably led by its long-time mayor, Ralph M. Owens, and the city
13 councilmembers, Thomas E. Cole, Mary L. Jackson, W. Freddie Lee, and David Whitworth;

15 WHEREAS, the restored downtown city park and railroad depot attract tourists and is the
16 setting for the romantic exchange of wedding vows; and

17 WHEREAS, Lavonia was recently recognized as a most desired community for retirement
18 and participates in the Better Hometown program; and

3 endorse its selection as a "City of Excellence."
