A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Alfonzo L. Hall, President and Chief Executive Officer of International Agile
2 Manufacturing, LLC (I.A.M.); and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Alfonzo L. Hall, the President and Chief Executive Officer of International
4 Agile Manufacturing, LLC (I.A.M.), decided to pay tribute to the victims of the Attack on
5 America on September 11, 2001; and

6 WHEREAS, out of his desire to honor the victims of this horrible act of terrorism was born
7 the idea of creating a commemorative medallion cast from some of the structural steel at the
8 site of the World Trade Center in New York that collapsed on that fateful day; and

9 WHEREAS, he strongly believed that the tremendous human loss could be memorialized and
10 the contributions and lives of victims remembered with care by recasting some of the steel
11 into simple markers that contain a meaningful message regarding American unity; and

12 WHEREAS, the proceeds from the sale of these commemorative medallions are to augment
13 the national fund for the World Trade Center victims and genuine compassion and care
14 forged this simple symbol of our strength as a nation.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 recognize and commend Alfonzo L. Hall, President and Chief Executive Officer of
17 International Agile Manufacturing, LLC (I.A.M.), on his efforts to commemorate the human
18 loss on September 11, 2001.
