ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution so as to provide that the Supreme Court shall
- 2 have jurisdiction over questions of law from any state appellate or federal court; to provide
- 3 for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for other purposes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 SECTION 1.

- 6 Article VI, Section VI of the Constitution is amended by striking Paragraph IV and inserting
- 7 in lieu thereof a new Paragraph IV to read as follows:
- 8 "Paragraph IV. Jurisdiction over questions of law from state appellate or federal
- 9 **appellate courts.** The Supreme Court shall have jurisdiction to answer any question of law
- from any state <u>appellate</u> or federal appellate court."

11 SECTION 2.

- 12 The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as
- provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the
- 14 above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following:
- 15 "() YES Shall the Constitution be amended so as to provide that the Supreme Court
- shall have jurisdiction to answer questions of law from any state appellate
- 17 () NO or federal court?"
- 18 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 19 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 20 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 21 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
