## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

| 6  | SECTION 1.  |
| 7  | Code Section 9-11-16 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to pretrial              |
| 8  | procedure, formulating issues, the pretrial order, and the pretrial calendar, is amended by       |
| 9  | striking in its entirety subsection (b) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:              |
| 10 | "(b) The court shall make an order which recites the action taken at the conference and the       |
| 11 | agreements made by the parties as to any of the matters considered and which limits the           |
| 12 | issues for trial to those not disposed of by admissions or agreements of counsel. The order,      |
| 13 | when entered, controls the subsequent course of the action unless modified at the trial <u>in</u> |
| 14 | the discretion of the court to prevent manifest injustice. Such modification may include          |
| 15 | the admission or exclusion of evidence or witnesses not contained in the pretrial order as        |
| 16 | originally entered. The court, in its discretion, may establish by rule a pretrial calendar on    |
| 17 | which actions may be placed for consideration as provided in subsection (a) of this Code          |
| 18 | section and may either confine the calendar to jury actions or to nonjury actions or extend       |
| 19 | it to all actions."   |
