

Senate Bill 78

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-5-32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
2 expiration and renewal of licenses, so as to require persons applying for renewal of a driver's
3 license who have accumulated a violation point count of two or more points to take and pass
4 the examination; to authorize the commissioner to issue necessary rules and regulations; to
5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 40-5-32 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the expiration
9 and renewal of licenses, is amended by inserting at the end thereof a new subsection (c) to
10 read as follows:

11 "(c) The department shall require every person applying for renewal of a driver's license
12 who has accumulated a violation point count of two or more points under Code Section
13 40-5-57 during the four years following the issuance of such license to take and pass
14 successfully each component of the examination provided for in Code Section 40-5-27,
15 including tests of driving skill and knowledge. The commissioner shall issue such rules
16 and regulations as are necessary to implement this subsection."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
