A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending Senior Girl Scout Kymberly Burkhead; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Kymberly Burkhead of Stone Mountain, Georgia, is a Senior Girl Scout in
3 Troop 3624 and is currently completing her community service project for the Girl Scout
4 Gold Award, the highest award in Girl Scouting; and
- 5 WHEREAS, in recognition of the 90th anniversary of Girl Scouting in the United States and
6 to highlight Georgia as the state in which this special youth movement was founded,
7 Kymberly invited the First Lady Marie Barnes, Secretary of State Cathy Cox, and all the
8 female state legislators to join the *Honorary State of Georgia Girl Scout Troop 1912*; and
- 9 WHEREAS, February 7, 2002 was "Girl Scout Day at the Georgia State Capitol" and an
10 investiture ceremony for Troop 1912 was held in the State Capitol Rotunda; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the idea of establishing Troop 1912 composed of women in the Georgia General
12 Assembly and prominent female state government leaders was a most meaningful occasion
13 for the honorary members and a brilliant way to mark the 90th anniversary of Girl Scouts.

15 the members of this body recognize and commend Senior Girl Scout Kymberly Burkhead
