- 2 WHEREAS, Micah Lancaster is a resident of Laurens County, Georgia, in the Dublin area

- 4 WHEREAS, on February 17, 2002, Representative Mitchell Kaye and his wife, Amy, were
5 traveling west on I-16 to return home from a tour of south Georgia where he was
6 campaigning for State School Superintendent; and

9 were open to the public; and
