

## Senate Resolution 477

**ADOPTED SENATE**

## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending all firefighters, law enforcement personnel, emergency medical technicians,  
2 and other public safety providers and declaring January 30, 2002, as "Public Safety  
3 Employees Day in Georgia"; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia is served daily by the thousands of firefighters, law  
5 enforcement personnel, emergency medical technicians, and other public safety providers  
6 who have dedicated themselves to the protection of the lives and property of our citizens; and

7 WHEREAS, it is largely upon their courage and commitment that our fundamental liberties  
8 and well-being are built and secured; and

9 WHEREAS, in rendering essential public services professionally and selflessly, this state's  
10 public safety providers help to assure an orderly society and enhances the citizenry's sense  
11 of security; and

12 WHEREAS, in placing the well-being of society above their personal concerns and, in some  
13 instances, risking their lives for the sake of others, the public safety providers in this state  
14 exemplify the highest nobility and greatest commitment to humanitarian ideals; and

15 WHEREAS, it is most fitting and proper that the courage and contributions of the  
16 firefighters, law enforcement personnel, emergency medical technicians, and other public  
17 safety providers be duly recognized and commended.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
19 express their profound gratitude to all the firefighters, law enforcement personnel, emergency  
20 medical technicians, and other public safety providers within the State of Georgia and  
21 proudly acknowledge January 30, 2002, as "Public Safety Employees Day in Georgia."
