9 1994-97, Dallas Cowboys, 1998-99, as head coach, and the Miami Dolphins, 2000-01, as
10 offensive coordinator; and

12 his accomplishments, and he has a superb reputation as a great teacher and trainer and as an
13 individual who has a positive influence on all those around him; and

15 dedicated native son will do a fantastic job for the state he so dearly loves. Welcome home!
