A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Staff Sergeant James Watson, USMC, of Powder Springs; and for other
2 purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Staff Sergeant James Watson, USMC, is assigned to Marine Aviation Logistics
4 Squadron 42, NAS Marietta; and

5 WHEREAS, he has demonstrated leadership not only in the Corps but also in veterans
6 affairs, having served as chairman of the Powder Springs Veterans Committee and, through
7 his membership in American Legion Post 294 of Powder Springs, as 1st Junior Vice
8 Commander and 5th District Sergeant at Arms; and

9 WHEREAS, he originated and successfully spearheaded the drive to construct a monument
10 to honor all military veterans in Powder Springs, including fund-raising and publicity, and
11 he served as master of ceremonies at groundbreaking ceremonies for the monument, which
12 was completed and dedicated in November, 2001; and

14 in the First United Methodist Church of Marietta, Powder Springs Business Association, and
