A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regrets at the passing of Norman Warren Fries; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Norman Warren Fries was a prominent businessman, civic leader, and generous
- 3 philanthropist in Claxton, Georgia, where he was the largest employer in Evans County and
- 4 positively influenced the quality of life for his fellow citizens; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he was a native of Chatham County who after serving in the US Navy during
- 6 World War II and attending Duke University entered the poultry business in 1949, having
- 7 worked for his father, T.W. Fries, owner of Fries Poultry in Savannah's old City Market; and
- 8 WHEREAS, as an entrepreneur he invested his talent and industry and created Claxton
- 9 Poultry which formed the core of the local economy and today remains one of the last
- 10 family-owned broiler production companies in the United States; and
- 11 WHEREAS, he was a major figure in the state and national poultry industry, having served
- 12 as past president of the Georgia Poultry Processors, past director of the Georgia Egg
- 13 Association and Georgia Poultry Improvement Association, and past chairman of the Poultry
- 14 Marketing Advisory Committee for the Georgia Department of Agriculture; and
- 15 WHEREAS, in 1999 he received the Poultry Industry Lifetime Achievement Award from
- 16 the National Poultry Food and Distributors Association; Georgia Southern University named
- 17 their Distinguished Lectureship Series in his honor; and he currently served as the director
- 18 of the National Chicken Council.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body expresses deep
- 20 regret at the passing of Norman W. Fries and conveys its sympathy to his beloved family.
- 21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 22 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the family of Norman W. Fries.
