ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Julian E. Dutton; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Julian E. Dutton was a well-known and highly respected business and civic
3 leader whose leadership, experience, and wisdom greatly influenced the quality of life in his
4 native Tattnall County and benefited his fellow citizens; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he was born June 7, 1922, in Glennville, Georgia; served his country with honor
6 during World War II, and was a member of Philadelphia Lodge #73 and American Legion
7 Post #95 for more than 50 years; and
- 8 WHEREAS, he was committed to community service and was a former Glennville City
9 Councilman, former Chairman of Tattnall County Board of Education, and served for many
10 years on the Tattnall County Democratic Executive Committee where he was instrumental
11 in electing his party's candidates to city, county, and state public office; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was the chief administrative officer of Glenvue Nursing Home and provided
13 direction and assistance to clients and their families with integrity and compassion; and
- 14 WHEREAS, his good judgment, business acumen, and accountability made him a valued
15 public servant whose counsel was sought on significant issues and political decisions and his
16 leadership and presence will be sorely missed.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body regrets the
18 passing of Julian E. Dutton and conveys its sympathy to the members of his family.
