**ADOPTED SENATE**

**A RESOLUTION**

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Thomas Robert Cox; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Thomas Robert Cox was a native and lifelong resident of Bulloch County where  
3 his knowledge and experience as a business director and his civic and political leadership  
4 were recognized and highly regarded; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he was a director and member of the Bulloch County Farm Bureau, a member  
6 of the Georgia Tobacco Commodity Commission for the past 30 years and a former chairman  
7 for several terms; a director of the Bulloch Telephone Cooperative and a director of the  
8 AgSouth Farm Credit; and a member of the Farm Credit Council; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he served as the chairman of the Board of Commissioners of Bulloch County  
10 from 1985 to 1992, and his marvelous ability to guide and direct local government fiscal  
11 affairs and services made him a highly admired and trusted public official; and
- 12 WHEREAS, in addition to his extensive community service, he was a member of the  
13 Statesboro Primitive Baptist Church for 50 years where he was a devout deacon and teacher;  
14 and the presence and counsel of this loving husband and father will be sorely missed.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body expresses regret  
16 at the passing of Thomas Robert Cox, who contributed substantially to his community, and  
17 conveys its sympathy to his beloved family.
