**ADOPTED SENATE**

**A RESOLUTION**

- 1 Expressing regret at the passing of Dale T. Warren; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Dale T. Warren was a highly respected community leader in the City of Atlanta  
3 where he was well known for his involvement and initiatives on neighborhood issues; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was a successful business manager who made a commitment to serve his  
5 community and contribute to improvements in local government policy; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he spearheaded an early focus on Atlanta's neighborhood concerns and helped  
7 organize the South Atlantans for Neighborhood Development where he served as president  
8 in 1990, and his leadership there made him a natural chair for the City of Atlanta  
9 Neighborhood Economic Development Task Force in 1993; and
- 10 WHEREAS, his success as a neighborhood advocate earned him an appointment to the City  
11 of Atlanta Charter Review Commission where he was legislative committee chair in 1994  
12 and a representative on the Georgia Future Community Commission in 1995; and

- 14 WHEREAS, he became especially visible in 1997-98 as a City of Atlanta License Review  
15 Board member and in the years that followed served as a member, vice chair and chair of the  
16 powerful City of Atlanta Zoning Review Board; and
- 17 WHEREAS, his tremendous experience and earnest approach to community problems and  
18 issues resulted in many significant achievements, and this talented, trusted, treasured friend  
19 will be sorely missed and long remembered.
- 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that this body expresses regret  
21 at the passing of Dale T. Warren and conveys its sympathy to his family.
