A RESOLUTION

- 1 Designating the William S. Hutchings Bridge at the Interstate 75 South and SR 74
- 2 interchange in Macon; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, William S. "Bill" Hutchings was a pillar of the Macon community, whose
- 4 influence touched numerous aspects of community life from education to business; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he owned and managed one of the oldest black businesses in Bibb County, and
- 6 he served many years on the Bibb County Board of Education; and
- 7 WHEREAS, he served in the U.S. Army during World War II and afterwards graduated from
- 8 Lincoln University and Atlanta College of Mortuary Science; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was the first African American to be elected county-wide in Bibb County
- 10 since Reconstruction, the first African American to be appointed to the Georgia State Board
- of Funeral Services, and the first African American to serve as president of such board; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Hutchings passed from this life on December 8, 2000, and it is only fitting
- and proper that his memory be honored by the General Assembly.
- 14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY that the bridge
- at the Interstate 75 South and SR 74 interchange in Macon is designated the William S.
- 16 Hutchings Bridge, and the Department of Transportation is authorized and directed to erect
- and maintain signs so identifying the bridge.
- 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
- 19 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to the Department of Transportation and the
- 20 family of William S. Hutchings.
