ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Robert M. Manton; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Robert M. Manton of Acworth, in Paulding County, Georgia, was recently
3 recognized for his successful and efficient use of the 911 emergency system to obtain help
4 for his father during a medical emergency; and

5 WHEREAS, on December 9, 2001, ten-year old Robert, upon realizing that his father was
6 having seizures, called 911, told the operator his name, address, and phone number as well
7 as his grandmother's cell phone number and provided a description of his house, the kind of
8 cars in the driveway, and the name of the medication that his father was taking; and

9 WHEREAS, this heroic young man stayed by his father's side until help arrived; and

10 WHEREAS, on January 24, 2002, this outstanding and remarkable young man was one of
11 eight young people awarded a 911 hero certificate and medal at the Capitol on 911
12 Appreciation Day; and

13 WHEREAS, in a world which consistently seems to accentuate the negative aspects of the
14 actions of young people, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize with
15 particularity the heroic actions of this young man.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 commend Robert M. Manton for his courageous and heroic response to crisis, congratulate
18 him on his award, and express their best wishes for the future to him and his family.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
20 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to Robert M. Manton.
