## A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the Chesley V. Morton Interchange; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Chesley V. Morton has long been recognized by the citizens of DeKalb County  
3 for the vital role that he has played in community leadership and his deep personal  
4 commitment to the welfare of the citizens of Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, he has diligently and conscientiously devoted innumerable hours of his time,  
6 talents, and energy toward the betterment of his community and state as evidenced by the  
7 eight years in which he served as a member of the Georgia House of Representatives; and

8 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience  
9 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of his  
10 community have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

11 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for  
12 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
14 distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
16 GEORGIA that this body commends Chesley V. Morton as an exemplary citizen and  
17 designates the interchange at Chamblee Tucker Road and I-85 in DeKalb County as the  
18 Chesley V. Morton Interchange.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Department of Transportation is authorized and  
20 directed to erect and maintain appropriate signs so designating such interchange.
