

House Bill 1612

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing a supplement to the salary of the judge of the Superior Court of
2 the Cherokee Judicial Circuit, approved March 22, 1963 (Ga. L. 1963, p. 182), as amended,
3 particularly by an Act approved March 28, 1985 (Ga. L. 1985, p. 4663), and an Act approved
4 April 5, 1994 (Ga. L. 1994, p. 4779), so as to change the supplement to be paid to each judge
5 and to the district attorney of such circuit; to provide for related matters; to provide an
6 effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:**

8 **SECTION 1.**

9 An Act providing a supplement to the salary of the judge of the Superior Court of the
10 Cherokee Judicial Circuit, approved March 22, 1963 (Ga. L. 1963, p. 182), as amended,
11 particularly by an Act approved March 28, 1985 (Ga. L. 1985, p. 4663), and an Act approved
12 April 5, 1994 (Ga. L. 1994, p. 4779), is amended by striking Section 9 in its entirety and
13 inserting in its place the following:

14 "SECTION 9.

15 The judges of the Superior Court of the Cherokee Judicial Circuit shall receive, in addition
16 to the compensation and allowances paid to the judges of the superior courts in this state,
17 the sum of \$20,000.00 per annum, payable monthly. The district attorney shall receive the
18 sum of \$18,000.00 per annum, payable monthly, which shall be in addition to the
19 compensation and allowances paid to the district attorney by the state and shall be in lieu
20 of all fees and other perquisites. Both the above-mentioned salaries shall be paid out of the
21 funds of the Counties of Gordon and Bartow and shall be apportioned among those two
22 counties on a per capita basis according to the United States decennial census of 2000 or
23 any future such census."

1 **SECTION 2.**

2 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2002.

3 **SECTION 3.**

4 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
