ADOPTED SENATE**A RESOLUTION**

1 Expressing deep regret at the loss of four Savannah area builders and utility representatives;
2 and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, a private plane carrying four Savannah men: homebuilders C. A. "Tony" Griffin
4 and Bobby Reed, Jr., and Savannah Electric marketing representatives Mark W. Neville and
5 Rodney J. Hall fatally crashed in the rain on Wednesday afternoon, February 6, 2002; and

6 WHEREAS, these respected members of the Savannah homebuilders community and
7 residential marketing representatives from Savannah Electric were returning home from the
8 state Homebuilders Association convention in Atlanta; and

9 WHEREAS, the tremendous, tragic loss to their families and to the larger community in
10 which they lived, worked, and contributed their valuable talent and energy will be felt and
11 will linger in the hearts of many; and

12 WHEREAS, each of these very dedicated and responsible men will be long remembered by
13 their respective circles of family and friends, and the significant influence they had in their
14 professional fields and in the business, civic, and religious affairs of their communities
15 brought honor and credit to them and to their beloved families.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
17 express their deep regret at the tragic loss of C.A. "Tony" Griffin, Bobby Reed, Jr., Mark W.
18 Neville, and Rodney J. Hall and convey their heartfelt sympathy to the respective families
19 of these honorable men from Savannah, Georgia.
