A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 40-2-85.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
2 special and distinctive license plates for veterans, so as to provide that veterans' tags may be  
3 issued to a business in which a qualified veteran has an ownership interest if the business  
4 provides a vehicle for use by the veteran; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting  
5 laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Code Section 40-2-85.1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to special and  
9 distinctive license plates for veterans, is amended by inserting a new subsection (d.1) to read  
10 as follows:

11 "(d.1) Special license plates issued under this Code section may be issued to a business in  
12 which a qualified veteran has an ownership interest if the business provides a vehicle for  
13 use by the veteran. The commissioner may by rule or regulation establish procedures to  
14 administer this subsection including procedures to require proof that the vehicle is for use  
15 by an eligible veteran. A veteran shall be limited to no more than one special license plate,  
16 either individually or through the business in which the veteran has an ownership interest."

17 **SECTION 2.**

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
