A RESOLUTION

- 1 Honoring and welcoming the Honorable Richard J. Santos; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Richard J. Santos is the National Commander of the American Legion; and
- 3 WHEREAS, he was elected to that distinguished post during the 83rd national convention
4 of the American Legion; and
- 5 WHEREAS, he is an active member of American Legion Post 136 in Greenbelt, Maryland;

- 7 WHEREAS, he has served as a member of the Veterans Affairs and Rehabilitation
8 Commission, the Citizens Flag Alliance, the Policy Coordination and Action Group, the
9 Veterans Planning and Coordinating Committee, and the Legislative Commission of the
10 American Legion; and
- 11 WHEREAS, in recognition of his outstanding ability, he was appointed by the Governor of
12 Maryland to serve as a member of the Maryland Veterans Commission and the Maryland
13 Military Monuments Commission, making admirable contributions to both; and
- 14 WHEREAS, as part of his official visit to American Legion posts and veterans in Georgia,
15 he will visit Columbus, Smyrna, Jonesboro, Gainesville, and Calhoun; and
- 16 WHEREAS, it is an honor and privilege to welcome such a distinguished visitor to the State
17 of Georgia.

19 commends the Honorable Richard J. Santos, sincerely welcomes him to the State of Georgia,
