- 2 WHEREAS, Daniel Stensland of Boy Scout Troop 350 in Acworth has been awarded the
3 rank of Eagle Scout, the highest recognition conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and
- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the Eagle Scout rank must complete a rigorous program of
5 training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques; and
- 6 WHEREAS, few boys ever reach this lofty level of achievement and Daniel has ably
7 demonstrated the various special skills taught through the Boy Scout program and completed
8 a substantial community service project researching wildlife found on the nature trail at Ford
9 Elementary School, writing a guide, and building educational displays of animal life; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this outstanding young man has truly exhibited a commitment to the scouting
11 principles of honesty, fairness, and community service; and he has consistently conducted
12 himself in a manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and
- 13 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper for this body to recognize the excellent
14 accomplishments of this very dedicated Boy Scout.
- 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 commend Daniel Stensland for his diligence and dedication in pursuing the highest award
17 in the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on attaining the prestigious rank of
18 Eagle Scout conferred on December 3, 2001.
