- 2 WHEREAS, Whitfield County and the State of Georgia recently lost a distinguished citizen
3 and educator with the passing of Walter Howard; and
- 4 WHEREAS, he was an outstanding teacher at Northwest Whitfield High School and had
5 recently been selected as the Georgia Association for Career and Technical Education
6 Outstanding Educator of the Year for 2001-2002; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Georgia Association for Career and Technical Education is composed of
8 teachers and supporters who promote career and technical education in Georgia's curriculum,
9 and its awards program recognizes schools and teachers demonstrating high levels of
10 performance; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Walter Howard was known and loved for his dedication to his students, his
12 abilities as a teacher, and for the exemplary manner in which he introduced his students to
13 healthcare sciences, family and consumer services, business education, marketing, finance,
14 and numerous other aspects of career and technical education; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he was known for his leadership, encouragement to students, and devotion to
16 providing the best educational opportunities possible.
- 17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 recognize the life and accomplishments of Walter Howard and express their deepest
19 sympathy at his passing to the members of his family.

21 to transmit appropriate copies of this resolution to Mrs. Walter Howard and to the Georgia
