- of awards, including 100 Most Influential Women in Georgia for the year 2000; 1999
- 14 Woman of Vision; 1998 Public Health Leadership Institute Scholar; 1997 Excellence in

- 16 Award; Women for Morris Brown College; 1995 Image and Style Maker Award, American
- 17 Cancer Society, Mid Atlanta Unit; 1993 America's Best and Brightest Award, Dollars and
- 18 Sense Magazine; 1992 Influential State Leader, Georgia Coalition of Black Women; and
- 19 1991 Who's Who of Women in the World; and
- 20 WHEREAS, her significant organizational and leadership talents, remarkable patience and
- 21 diplomacy, keen sense of vision, and sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of her community
- 22 have earned her the respect and admiration of colleagues and associates; and
- 23 WHEREAS, she is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
- 24 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and
