- 1 Recognizing GAE Legislative Conference Day; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Georgia Association of Educators (GAE) is the oldest organization in  
3 Georgia to represent school employees in every public school district in Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, the GAE represents public school teachers, administrators, education support  
5 personnel, retired educators, and college students and faculty; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the GAE supports efforts to protect the health and safety of all children and  
7 public school employees; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the GAE advocates stalwartly for positive changes in public education; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the GAE works assiduously to empower educators to make a difference in the  
10 lives of children; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the GAE works untiringly to improve Georgia's public schools; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the GAE continues to support efforts to attract and retain well qualified,  
13 prepared educators to teach every child in Georgia's public schools; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the GAE supports efforts to prepare children for the jobs of tomorrow; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the GAE supports efforts to protect and expand the rights and benefits of all  
16 school employees; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the GAE annually conducts a legislative conference providing an opportunity  
18 for GAE members from every school district to discuss legislative priorities with members  
19 of the Georgia General Assembly.

2 recognize February 25, 2002, as GAE Legislative Conference Day and convey all the  
3 accolades and appreciation possible to acknowledge the dedicated hard work of every public
