

House Bill 1630

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Part 4 of Article 3 of Chapter 5 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia  
2 Annotated, relating to minority business enterprise development, so as to require the  
3 Department of Administrative Services to issue a Minority Business Enterprise Participation  
4 Report by October 1 of each year; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws;  
5 and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 Part 4 of Article 3 of Chapter 5 of Title 50 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,  
9 relating to minority business enterprise development, is amended by inserting at the end  
10 thereof a new Code Section 50-5-134 to read as follows:

11 "50-5-134.

12 (a) By October 1 of each year, beginning in 2004, the Department of Administrative  
13 Services shall compile and make public a report to be known as the Minority Enterprise  
14 Participation Report which shall contain data identifying the percentage of the contracts for  
15 construction, goods, equipment, and services entered into by each agency or department  
16 of the state during the preceding fiscal year with a minority business enterprise. Such  
17 report shall classify a minority business enterprise by the following designations: Black;  
18 Hispanic; Asian-Pacific American; Native American; or Asian-Indian American.

19 (b) It shall be the duty and responsibility of the head of each department, institution, or  
20 agency of the state to furnish, upon written request by the Department of Administrative  
21 Services on such forms provided by it, the data required under subsection (a) of this Code  
22 section."

23 **SECTION 2.**

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
