A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the students of 21st Century Leaders and recognizing 21st Century Leaders
2 Day at the Capitol; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, 21st Century Leaders, operated under the charter of The Georgia Business
4 Forum, Inc., is a nonprofit organization that collaborates with business and education leaders
5 to develop, inspire, and nurture students with high potential to make a positive impact on
6 their schools, communities, and future places of work; and

7 WHEREAS, the mission of the 21st Century Leaders is to increase the number, skills, and
8 diversity of Georgia's future leaders by delivering world-class business leadership training
9 to Georgia high school students with high leadership aptitude who are from diverse
10 backgrounds; and

11 WHEREAS, more than 1,300 students from more than 80 Georgia high schools and counties
12 have participated in the program and more than 100 Georgia companies have supported the
13 program through funding and volunteers; and

14 WHEREAS, nearly 94 percent of students who participate in 21st Century Leaders
15 matriculate to college; and

16 WHEREAS, 21st Century Leaders practice their leadership skills by providing a "youth
17 voice" to the business and professional community by leading their schools in community
18 service projects and by networking with top leaders from across the state.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body recognize March 1, 2002, as 21st Century Leaders Day at the
21 Capitol.
