ADOPTED SENATE

A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the members of the Silver-Haired Legislature; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, the Silver-Haired Legislature provides a special forum for the presentation and
3 deliberation of contemporary issues affecting the elderly by convening an artificial
4 lawmaking assembly composed of representatives elected from every legislative district in
5 the state; and
- 6 WHEREAS, many distinguished Georgians have participated in the Silver-Haired
7 Legislature and this legislative model is a valuable means of educating the public regarding
8 legislative procedures while stimulating an interest in the political process; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the legislative recommendations distilled from the Silver-Haired Legislature
10 have contributed to a better understanding of the merits and limitations of many popular
11 proposals and provided a meaningful opportunity for the elderly in Georgia to get involved
12 in current issues of consequence.
- 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
14 commend the members of the Silver-Haired Legislature on their careful consideration of
15 various legislative proposals affecting the elderly and congratulate them on their dedication
16 and involvement in the political process.
- 17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
18 to transmit an appropriate copy of this resolution to the Silver-Haired Legislature.
