A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the North Georgia College and State University's Blue Ridge Rifles and Color
- 2 Guard; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Blue Ridge Rifles and Color Guard won first place at the 30th annual
- 4 Tulane University Mardi Gras Drill Meet, the largest intercollegiate military drill competition
- 5 in the nation, February 8, 2002; and
- 6 WHEREAS, the Blue Ridge Rifles and Color Guard defeated 46 other schools and placed
- 7 first for the third year straight; and
- 8 WHEREAS, the Tulane University Drill meet is the largest intercollegiate military drill
- 9 competition in the nation. It draws ROTC units in every service by branch from around the
- 10 country and the service academies also regularly compete; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the Blue Ridge Rifles competed in four of the events and took first place in
- 12 platoon exhibition, which is the Rifles' signature event that the team performs during
- 13 sporting events and military parades at the university; received a perfect score for its
- exhibition routine; and also took first place in basic drill and third place in inspection; and
- 15 WHEREAS, the Color Guard team took first place in its single event, a repeat from last year
- when the team won the Color Guard event at Tulane for the first time in the unit's history;

- 18 WHEREAS, the combined results for the Rifles and Color Guard won them the first place
- 19 military drill team title for the third year in a row and the seventh time in the past decade; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the continued success of the Blue Ridge Rifles is important to NGCSU because
- 21 it is a result of the character-focused, leadership training that the university strives to create;

- 3 and Texas A & M.; and

- 5 pride and consistently exhibit the desire to perform at the highest standards.
- 6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 7 commend the Blue Ridge Rifles and Color Guard of North Georgia College and State
- 8 University for winning its third consecutive national intercollegiate military drill competition
- 9 and express the pride of the entire State of Georgia for such an honor.
