- 14 seasons and where he set the career record for most touchdowns by recovery of opponents'

- WHEREAS, he serves as the spokesperson for the Fatherhood Campaign in Georgia, served
 as the national spokesperson for the United Way in 1996, was the Falcons' 1993 Man of the
- 18 Year, and received the Peach of an Athlete award in 1996; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he has made substantial contributions to the success and improvement of20 Valdosta State Blazer athletics; and
