A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending the Girl Scouts of the USA on its 90th birthday; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Juliette Gordon Low and her cousin registered the first Girl Scout troop on
- 3 March 12, 1912, in Savannah, Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Juliette Gordon Low's interest in the Scout movement stemmed from her
- 5 friendship with Robert and Agnes Baden-Powell who organized the Boy Scouts and its sister
- 6 organization, the Girl Guides, in England; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Juliette Gordon Low formed a small troop of Girl Guides in Scotland and two
- 8 in London before returning to the United States to organize the first Girl Scout troop in
- 9 Savannah in 1912; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the headquarters of the Girl Scouts was established in Washington, D.C., in
- 11 1913, and was later moved to New York City; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the Girl Scout movement has grown rapidly through the years throughout the
- 13 United States; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Girl Scouts of the USA is now the world's largest organization dedicated solely
- 15 to girls and, through its partnership with committed adult volunteers, Girl Scouts assists girls
- 16 to develop leadership skills, strong values, and a social conscience that will serve them all
- 17 of their lives; and
- 18 WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper that such a fine organization should be commended.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
- 20 congratulate the Girl Scouts of the USA on its 90th birthday and extend their wishes for
- 21 continued success.
