- 1 Commending Reverend Perry Price; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Reverend Perry Price is a native of Marietta and has been the most vocal civil
3 rights advocate in Cobb County for more than two decades; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Reverend Price is one of the most influential leaders in the Cobb County
5 African American community; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Reverend Price has been the most active religious and political member of the
7 Cobb County branch of the NAACP and served on the executive board thereof; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Reverend Price organized the Southern Christian Leadership Conference in
9 Cobb County at great personal sacrifice and at the risk of personal bodily harm and in fear of
10 incarceration, and he remains active in that organization; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Reverend Price is universally known through his involvement with politics on
12 the national, state, and local levels; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Reverend Price is an advocate for the homeless, the disenfranchised, the sick,
14 and the elderly, and he is a champion for causes that are politically incorrect and unpopular;
15 and
- 16 WHEREAS, Reverend Price is a man of unblemished character and fortitude without fear
17 of man, only God.
- 18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
19 the members of this body commend Reverend Perry Price for his contributions to the welfare
20 of this state.
