

The House Committee on State Planning & Community Affairs - Local Legislation offered the following substitute to SB 144:

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act creating the Recorder's Court of Gwinnett County, approved March 27,
2 1972 (Ga. L. 1972, p. 3125), as amended, so as to change provisions relating to the salary of
3 the judges of such court; to provide an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

6 An Act creating the Recorder's Court of Gwinnett County, approved March 27, 1972 (Ga.
7 L. 1972, p. 3125), as amended, is amended by striking in its entirety Section 7 and inserting
8 in its place a new Section 7 to read as follows:

"SECTION 7.

Judges' compensation.

12 The salary of the judges of the recorder's court shall be equal to 80 percent of the salary
13 of a judge of superior court of the Gwinnett Judicial Circuit including any supplement,
14 which salary shall be paid by the governing authority of Gwinnett County. In addition,
15 each of the judges shall continue to receive all ordinary and routine benefits offered to
16 employees of the county. These benefits shall include any longevity or bonus pay, and all
17 other health, dental, retirement, or other benefits provided to county employees. The
18 governing authority shall also have the right to provide for an additional county supplement
19 for said judges if it determines it is appropriate and necessary."

SECTION 2.

20 This Act shall become effective January 1, 2003.
