- 2 WHEREAS, Honorable Dorothy B. Pelote has served with unparalleled ability as a member
3 of the House of Representatives since 1992; and
- 4 WHEREAS, this dynamic and powerful public servant has faithfully represented the citizens
5 of Chatham County with great distinction, dedication, and ability; and
- 6 WHEREAS, throughout her distinguished career as a member of this august body, the "Lady
7 from the 149th" has shown a keen understanding of education, health, and government
8 matters; and
- 9 WHEREAS, her consistently thorough consideration of the issues presented to this
10 deliberative body and her integrity and reliability have rightfully earned her the honor,

2 the 1998 Hudson Hill Community Award, the 1997 Martin Luther King Phenomenal Award,
3 the 1995 Certificate of Commendation for Dedicated and Professional Service from the
4 Georgia Emergency Management Agency, and the 1994 Legislative Service Award from the
5 Association of County Commissioners.

7 the members of this body unanimously honor and commend their most outstanding
8 colleague, Honorable Dorothy B. Pelote, for her personal and political influence in
