**ADOPTED SENATE**

**A RESOLUTION**

1 Commending Veterinarian Wilbur Neisler; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Dr. Wilbur Neisler is well known in Monroe County as a very dedicated and  
3 capable veterinarian who has assisted countless individuals and families with his knowledge  
4 and experience; and

5 WHEREAS, he is the son of Margaret and William Neisler, graduated from Butler High  
6 School in Taylor County in 1940, Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College in 1942, and  
7 Auburn University Veterinary School in 1945; and

8 WHEREAS, in 1946, he was recruited to practice in Monroe County, Georgia, and married  
9 Betty Smith from Forsyth in 1947 with whom he had two children: Faye who is married to  
10 Steve Melton and lives in Columbus, and Deck who is married to Brenda Bowen and lives  
11 in Lilburn; and they are blessed with a total of five grandchildren whom they thoroughly  
12 enjoy; and

13 WHEREAS, Dr. Neisler was elected and ordained as a Deacon in Forsyth First Baptist  
14 Church in 1950, and has been a devout member of the congregation; and

15 WHEREAS, he has been an active member of the Auburn Alumni Association, a substantial  
16 Tigers Unlimited supporter, and received the Golden Eagle award in 1995, an honor  
17 bestowed on 50 year graduates of distinction; and

19 compassion, and good will, and his community service deserves to be recognized.
